This is just what we need after the last year! Come and brush up your icon painting skills! Students will not work on a formal icon but will, rather, work on several exercise pieces. The first three days Tatiana and Dimitrii will guide students through the Prosopon approach to garment highlights, and the next three days will concern the iconic face. An excellent refresher for experienced students, as well as a perfect introduction for newer ones. No prep work is necessary. Practice boards and pigments will be provided. Please bring your own brushes.

These classes will help with a deeper understanding of the difference in the meaning of the three highlights, and the difference of their expression through the face and through garments. The face highlight class, or representing of the Holy Countenance in the iconic face, is dedicated to learning the difference between the iconic Holy Face, the human face, and the mask, and expressing spirituality by means of light. Students will practice the difference in application of three levels of highlights on the iconic face.

Class will run 9:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, 9:00 am – 2:00 pm Saturday, with an hour break for lunch each day. Light snacks, coffee, tea, and water are provided, as well as a microwave and fridge. \$250 tuition, checks written to Dimitrii Berestov, due the first day of class.
